

Heavy-Duty Service Diesel Mechanic-Vincennes

SUMMARY: The Heavy-Duty Service Diesel Mechanic performs skilled work in maintaining medium and heavy-duty trucks and trailers. Inspects, diagnoses and repairs diesel-powered heavy and medium-duty vehicles and machines, like trucks and trailers. The main duties of the Full-Service Diesel Mechanic include running diagnostic tests on vehicles, repairing the vehicles' electrical components, steering mechanism or braking systems, hydraulics, suspension, and test driving the vehicle to determine if they properly fixed the maintenance issue.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: include but are not limited to the following.

- Inspect equipment or materials to identify the cause of problems or defects.
- Perform routine maintenance on equipment and determine when and what kind of maintenance is needed.
- Inspect, repair, and maintain mechanical equipment.
- Raise trucks and heavy parts, or equipment using hydraulic jacks or hoists.
- Troubleshoot operation problems and determine plan of action to remedy problems.
- Install equipment, etc. to meet specifications.
- Complete all necessary paperwork, as required.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential function satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill and/or ability required.

LANGUAGE SKILLS: Ability to read and comprehend simple instructions. Ability to effectively and concisely present information in one-on-one and small group situations to customers and other employees. Ability to work from oral and written instructions. Proficient verbal communication skills, in English, are required.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

- A high school diploma or equivalent is required.
- Three (3) + years of experience in automotive mechanical maintenance.
- Heavy Equipment Mechanic experience is preferred.
- CDL is a plus.
- Knowledge of up-to-date methods of maintaining Heavy/Medium Duty vehicles and trailers.

- Knowledge of operating principles and maintenance of gasoline and diesel-powered engines.

(Comparable amount of training, education, or experience may be substituted for the above minimum requirements.)

COMPETATIVE WAGES: Wages based on skill set and service experience.

REASONING ABILITY: Ability to apply common-sense understanding to carry out instructions in written and oral form. Ability to deal with problems involving several concrete variances in standardized situations.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.

- **HEAVY WORK:** Lifting 100 lbs. maximum with frequent lifting and/or carrying of objects weighing up to 50 lbs.
- **PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:** Frequent lifting, carrying, pushing, pulling, stooping, kneeling, crawling, climbing, and balancing.
- **WORK POSITION:** Sitting 10%, standing 70% and walking 20%
- **WORK CONDITIONS:** Spends approximately 95% of the time in service bay, 5% moving trucks into Service Bay.
